Hypotheses are generated about the origins and causes of a patient's symptoms. The most common and clinically practical way to formulate is through the biopsychosocial approach, first described in 1980 by George Engel. [1]

An overview of case formulation

The case formulation should be developed in collaboration with the client to ensure engagement and increase commitment to treatment. To develop a strong case formulation, the following steps are recommended (Persons, 2008): Conduct a thorough assessment to determine the presence of specific diagnoses, symptoms, and problems.

Case Formulation in Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy: A ...

The following guidelines for case formulation (Persons, 2001), if used, will add to the initial assessment, and are consistent with the cognitive behavioural approach of this intervention. The formulation assists in the development of working hypotheses or clinical assumptions about how the client's beliefs (underlying mechanisms) shape their thoughts, mood and behaviour (overt level).

□A good treatment plan requires an assessment appropriate to the client's presenting concerns and a case conceptualization that includes an understanding of what the problem is, how it developed, and how to deal with the problem. □The formality of a treatment plan and the actual form that it takes varies from setting to setting.
